The International Monetary Fund (IMF) projects a growth rate of 6.1% in 2023 and 6.5% in 2024. Moreover, Vietnam is among nine nations in the world with the fastest-growing middle class in the coming decade. Consequently, Vietnam stands out as the fastest-growing economy in the ASEAN (Association of Southeast Asian Nations) region.

The horticulture and floriculture sectors are among the most promising industries in Vietnam's economy. Vietnam has been striving to enhance the quality and competitiveness of its fruits and vegetables to meet local demand and to boost their exports to other markets.

This in combination with many free trade agreements between Vietnam and partners, both within and outside the region, and strong domestic demand will further boost growth in the coming years.

Additionally, experts believe that Vietnam has the potential to become one of the world's most significant flower exporters.
